FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS:

During preparation of the conference, a collection of scientific papers is expected to be published.

The volume of each paper: 5-7 text pages, including figures, tables, and references. Font: Times New Roman; size – 12; spacing - single; paragraph indent-1.25; alignment - page width without hyphenation. File format: Word 2003-2013 (doc., docx). Sheet size: A4 (210*297), margins-2.5 cm on each side; Page numbers are not placed. Language – Russian, English.

Paper structure: abstract, introduction (brief), aim of research, material and methods, research results, concluding observations or conclusion. If available: reference to the source of funding.

Materials reflecting experience of coordinating the activities of government agencies, structural divisions of RAS, higher schools, environmental organizations and civil society institutes in solving the problems of conservation and use of natural and historical-cultural heritage objects and information support for ecological trails and historical-cultural routes are provided in a free form.

Text originality must be at least 80%.

PAPER FORMATTING:

- 1) UDC – enter the UDC code in bold in the upper left corner (UDC can be found on the website: <http://teacode.com/online/udc/>);
- 2) space-separated **TITLE (PAPER HEADING)** in Russian – semibold type, capital letters, centre alignment, the next line – the heading of paper in English, similarly formatted;
- 3) on the next line, separated by a space, **the authors' surnames and initials** in Russian, semibold type, centre alignment, the next line – the authors' initials and surnames in English, similarly formatted;
- 4) below – *the author's e-mail address* for correspondence;
- 5) one space below – *full name of organization, city, country*, in Russian, italic, centre alignment, next line – full name of organization, city, country in English;
- 6) one space below – *abstract* in Russian and English, *key words* in Russian and English, italic;
- 7) one space below – the text of paper. The text of paper can be presented in any of the working languages of the conference (Russian or English).

Tables and figures formatting. Tables and figures should be embedded in the text. All figures and tables in the text are referenced (fig. 1, table 1). Figure captions should be centered in italics below the figure, tables should have names, and table names should be centered in italics above the table. Illustrations are made in black and white format. The electronic version of each figure is sent as a separate file in .jpeg or .tiff format, resolving capacity of at least 300 dpi.

References formatting. Reference list is placed at the end of paper. References in the text: serial number in square brackets indicating the reference number in the reference list; sources are arranged in alphabetical order and formatted according to GOST 7.1-2003, the number of references is no more than 15.

The authors are responsible for the accuracy of the submitted materials. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject submitted materials in case of deviations from the requirements of manuscript preparation or inconsistencies of materials content to the themes of the conference. Correspondence will be carried out by e-mail.

Electronic materials formatting. The file containing the paper text should be named as follows: the Surname of the first author, the word "Paper", if the first author has several papers, after the word "Paper" it is necessary to indicate serial number (Ivanov paper1.doc). The name of file containing the figure: the Surname of the first author, the word "Figure", the serial number of drawing (if any).

**THE DEVELOPMENT OF MOUNTAIN TOURISM BASED ON THE

Abstract. *The paper presents the experience of mountain tourism development in the South-Eastern region of Poland in the Swietokrzyskie Mountains. In the past, the subsidized region began to develop successfully after the introduction of some changes in the approach to tourism. Tourism is currently one of the sectors of economic development bringing tangible financial benefits both locally and nationally. It is proposed to use Poland's experience in the North-Western region of the Caucasus, which has similar tourist potential.*
